

**Department of Livestock Development Notification**

Prescribing Conditions and Duration of Leniency on Importation of Especially Controlled Animal Feed from Place of Origin in case that Officers of Department of Livestock Development cannot travel to inspect the place of origin,  
B.E. 2563 (2020)

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Due to the situation of Coronavirus 2019 (Covid-19) Infection which has been spreading worldwide, having impact on travelling to inspect place of origin of especially controlled animal feed at the place of origin,

By virtue of clause 3 paragraph 2 of Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives Notification on Rule, Procedure and Condition of Import for Sale of Especially Controlled Animal Feed B.E. 2560 (2017), amended by Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives Notification on Rule, Procedure and Condition of Import for Sale of Especially Controlled Animal Feed (Version 3) B.E. 2563 (2020), Director General of Department of Livestock Development therefore issued this notification, that

Clause 1 This notification is called “Department of Livestock Development Notification on Conditions and Duration of Leniency on Importation of Especially Controlled Animal Feed from Place of Origin in case that Officers of Department of Livestock Development cannot travel to inspect the place of origin B.E. 2563 (2020)”.

Clause 2 This notification becomes enforced from the day after announced in the Government Gazette.

Clause 3 The leniency on importation of especially controlled animal feed is granted only for the case that officer(s) from the Department of Livestock Development cannot travel to inspect the place of origin, with the following conditions.

(1) Competent Authority of the producing country shall send an official letter to the Department of Livestock Development, requesting for the approval of the place of origin of especially controlled animal feed, supplemented with information of especially controlled animal feed intended for the approval as follows.

- (Kor) Product Information
- (Khor) Process Flowchart
- (Core) Certificate of Formula
- (Ngor) Certificate of Analysis

(2) Place of origin of especially controlled animal feed must be inspected by Competent Authority of the producing country by inspection of the establishment, production process, and animal feed production hygiene to meet hygienic practice and safe for animal health. Supply relevant document evident to the Department of Livestock Development.

(3) Officer(s) of the Department of Livestock Development may use video call to the establishment as a part of consideration, including request for photos, moving pictures and additional relevant documents to be sent via E-mail or Application.

(4) After officer(s) of the Department of Livestock Development have considered the operations in (1) (2) (3), the Reviewing Committee on the Inspection Results of Overseas Animal Feed Establishment shall consider the results in order to propose to the Department of Livestock Development for the leniency of importation.

Clause 4 The leniency of importation of especially controlled animal feed as in the Point 3 will end when the place of origin has been inspected and approved as a place of origin for especially controlled animal feed endorsed by the Department of Livestock Development, or, when the Director General instructs to end the leniency.
